RESOLUTION NO. 1202

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, WASHINGTON, certifying funding for the City of Des Moines S. 216th Street - Segment 2 (18th Ave. S. to 24th Ave. S.) Improvement Project.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Des Moines exists to promote the welfare of the citizens of Des Moines, Washington, and recognizes that improvements to S. 216th Street are necessary to sustain mobility and serve economic growth of the City, and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Transportation Plan for the City of Des Moines, was adopted as an element of the Comprehensive Plan and recommends that this roadway be widened to five lanes including bicycle and pedestrian improvements, and

WHEREAS, design of this Project is complete, the City has secured the necessary right of way for construction of the Project, and the City is prepared to advertise the Project for construction bids, and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines applied for a grant from the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (hereinafter "TIB") for a FY 2013 TIB Urban Corridor Project: S. 216th Street Improvements, Segment 2 (18th Avenue South to 24th Avenue S.), including its intersection with 24th Avenue S., and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2011 the TIB awarded \$4,000,000 in state TIB funds, subject to certification that local matching funds are reserved for the improvements pursuant to RCW 47.26.084, and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines and the Port of Seattle have approved the 2nd Development Agreement for the Des Moines Creek Business Park whereby the Port of Seattle agreed to provide \$2.5 million in funding for the S. 216th Street improvements, and

WHEREAS, King County Metro has agreed to provide up to \$20,000 in matching funds towards design and construction of new transit facility improvements; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Funding for the S. 216th Street - Segment 2 (18th Ave. S. to 24th Ave. S.) Improvement Project is secured and the City Council certifies that the necessary local matching funds will be available for construction.
