

**RESOLUTION NO. 1375**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, WASHINGTON,** declaring certain City Surface Water Management (SWM) vehicles and equipment surplus, and authorizing disposal of surplus vehicles and equipment by sale, auction, or trade-in.

**WHEREAS,** during regular business the City accumulates vehicles and equipment, and

**WHEREAS,** the City intends to dispose of unneeded vehicles and equipment as allowed by law as surplus, and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Des Moines typically sells surplus vehicles and equipment at public auction to the highest bidder or trades-in surplus vehicles and equipment at reputable dealerships, and

**WHEREAS,** the City desires to surplus the SWM vehicles and equipment identified in Exhibit "A" attached to this Resolution, and

**WHEREAS,** DMMC 3.108.060 provides that the City shall determine that equipment originally acquired by public utility purposes is surplus to the City's need and is not required for providing continued public utility service and then by resolution and after a public hearing may cause such equipment to be sold, leased, or conveyed, and

**WHEREAS,** the matter of surplus of SWM vehicles and equipment was set for a public hearing before the City Council on Thursday, January 11, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, and all persons wishing to be heard were heard; now therefore;

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Sec. 1.** The SWM vehicles and equipment identified by Exhibit "A" are hereby declared by this Resolution to be surplus vehicles and equipment.

**Sec. 2.** The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to dispose of the items identified by Exhibit "A" by sale, lease, or conveyance.

**Sec. 3.** The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to establish a minimum bid/sale amount for the property identified in Exhibit "A" as deemed to protect the City's interests.

**Sec. 4.** The City Manager is authorized to contract for professional auction services where the cost of such services does not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount bid, plus reasonable advertising fees.

**Sec. 5.** All net proceeds from the disposal of the surplus property identified in Exhibit "A" shall be deposited into the Equipment Replacement Fund.
